(S.2136 & H.R. 5150 - National) "HUMAN TRAFFICKING AND EXPLOITATION PREVENTION ACT OF 2021" and "Frederick Douglass Trafficking Victims Prevention and Protection Reauthorization Act of 2021" To amend the Public Health Service Act to provide for the implementation of curricula for training students, teachers, parents, and school and youth development personnel to understand, recognize, prevent, and respond to signs of human trafficking and exploitation in children and youth, and for other purposes.

(RULE # 6A-1.094123 - FL) CREATING A "CHILD TRAFFICKING FREE ZONE" School districts must annually provide instruction to students in grades K-12 related to child trafficking prevention and awareness. By December 1 of each year, each school district in Florida must submit an implementation plan.

(AB 1227 - CA) "HUMAN TRAFFICKING PREVENTION EDUCATION AND TRAINING ACT" Existing law authorizes a school district to provide sexual abuse and sex trafficking prevention education, as described, and authorizes the periodic conducting of in-service training of school district personnel relating to sexual abuse and sex trafficking.

(Amended H.B. 1 - OH) "SAFETY AND VIOLENCE PREVENTION TRAINING" requires ODE to develop a safety and violence prevention curriculum to train elementary school professionals to detect child abuse and prevent human trafficking.
